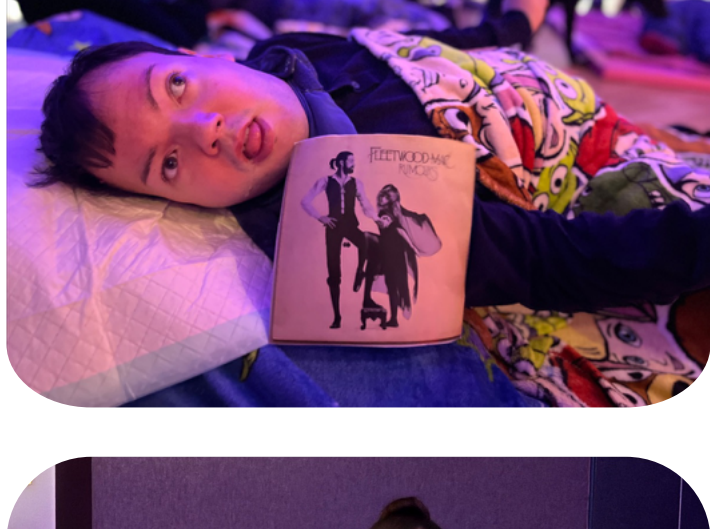
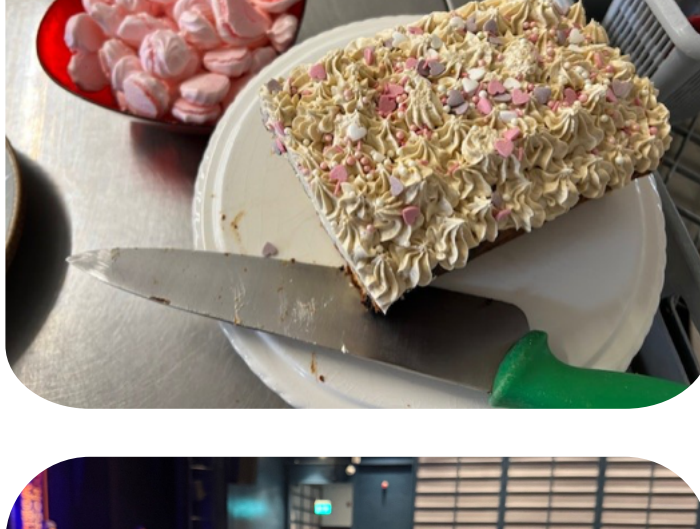
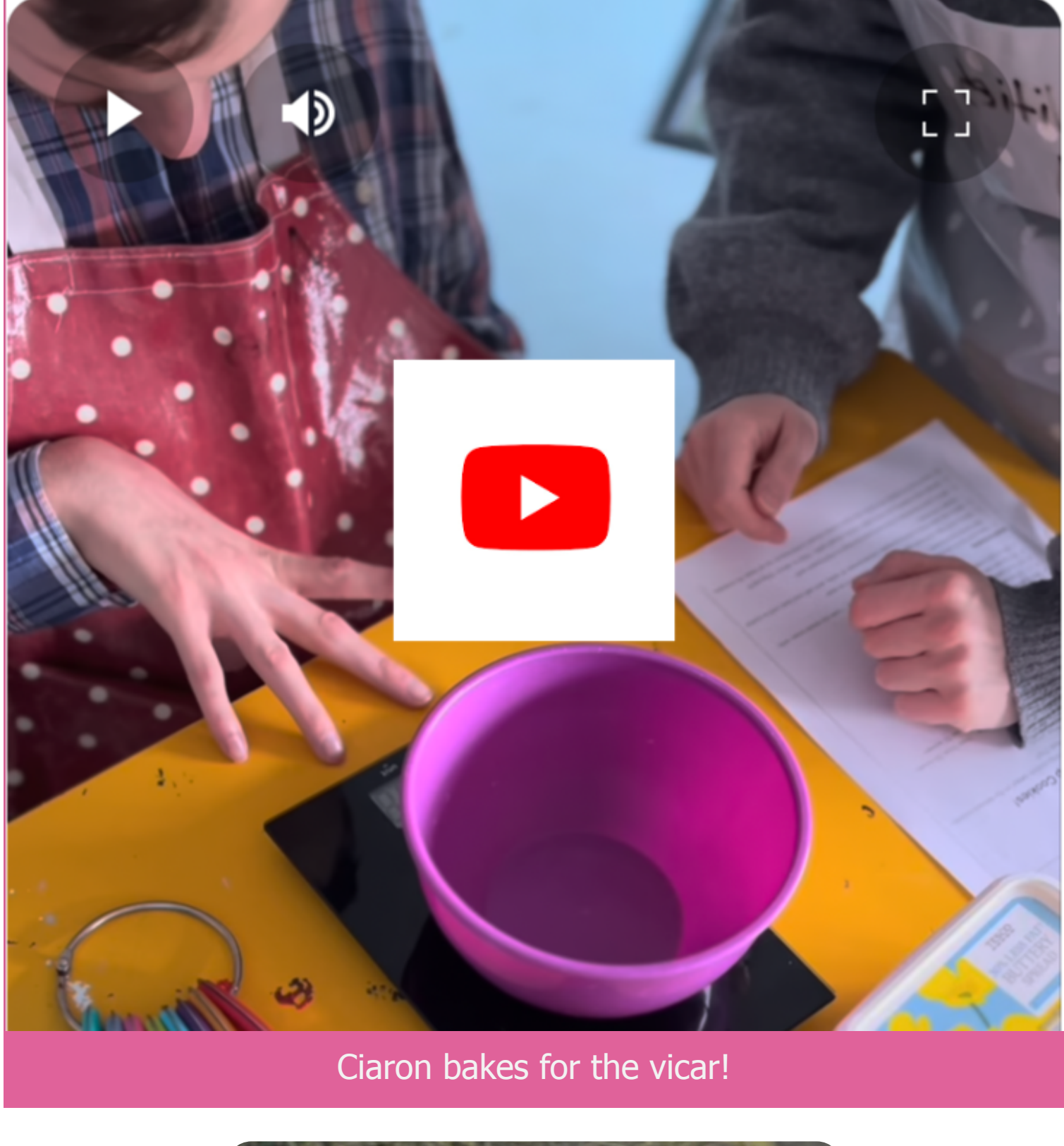
This month's **bowling championship** took a rare twist with Saleem emerging as the victor!
