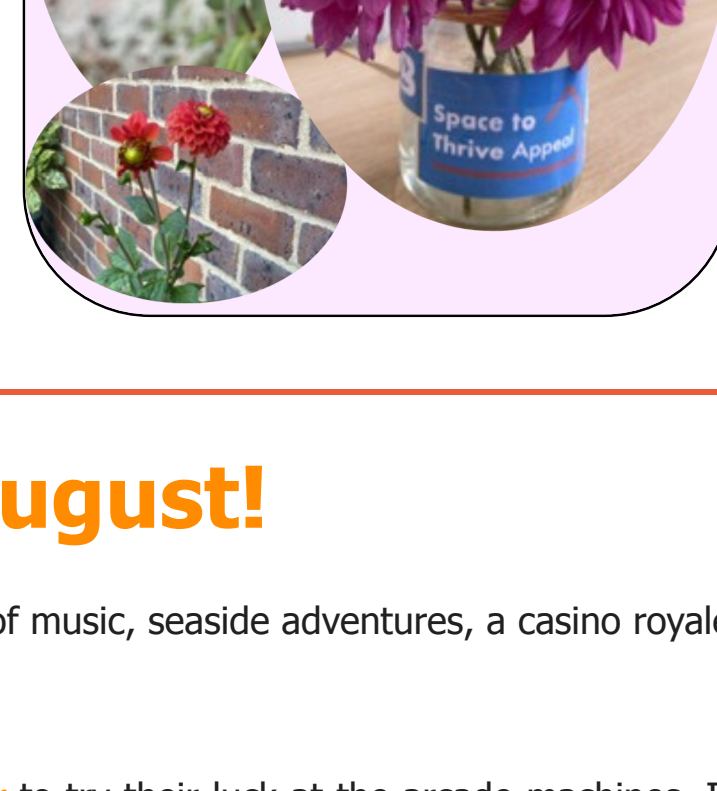
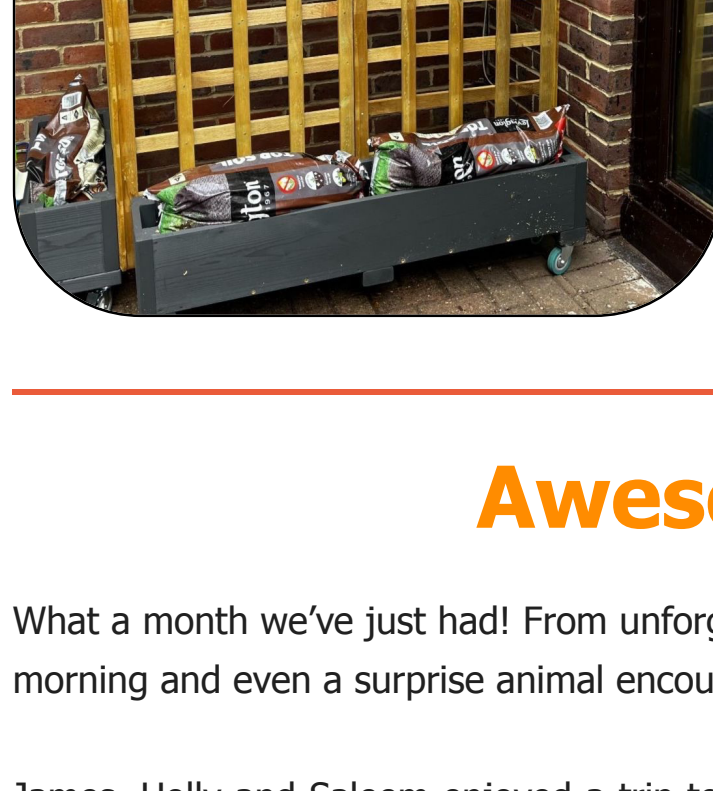
## Blooming at Bevern View
